Dungannon Window Company has engineered a fly screen for the **eurosash** which slides up and down with the top sash. The fly screen mesh is **totally concealed within the 'head' of the outer frame** so that the appearance of the window is not altered.

With sliding sash windows, insect protection has only been available by using a separate screen product that is fixed either behind or in front of the window, totally spoiling the look of your new sash windows.

Protection from flies, wasps, mosquitoes and moths has always been needed, especially in the following critical areas – kitchen windows, bathroom windows, farm houses, homes near lakes / ponds or wooded areas, hospitals, basically anywhere there are insects.

The new fly screen can be fitted into any **eurosash** during manufacture, and is a must for any home.

1 – Top sash window is closed



2 – Top sash partially open, you can see the screen is attached to the top of the top sash



3 - Top sash opening further, you can see that screen is coming down along with the sash



4 - The sash is full open, the sash is fully open and the screen is giving full protection.
