BS7950 (1997) is the recognised British Standard for security, this was revised for enhanced security in 2007. **To pass the revised test, the sashes have to be able to withstand 3 tonnes of force, using rams and 'jimmy bars'.**

In order for **eurosash** to comply with the new stringent tests, several changes for the hardware were required.

- **Heavy Duty Cam Locks**, made from stainless steel with captive hook retention into steel Cam Lock keep.
- **Deadlocking buttons** for the tilt latches.
- **Durable Nylon Polymer sash blocks** for the top sash.
- **Steel reinforcement pins** for tilt latch retention.

The necessary hardware required is **now on the shelf** and is ready to order, please see our BS7950 security flyer (available in downloads). We currently have a window going through the test so that **eurosash** can be certified to the new BS7950 standards by using the secure hardware.
